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EFFECTIVENESS OF PERFECT STUDYING OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES

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Abstract:

This article discusses the importance of perfect learning of foreign languages, effective methods used in teaching foreign languages to schoolchildren, and analyzes the results.

In today's modern world, learning foreign languages opens the door to a wide range of opportunities. Therefore, interest in learning foreign languages among young people is increasing day by day. This requires teachers use high-quality and innovative, effective methods.

In order to learn foreign languages perfectly, it is necessary to develop listening, reading, speaking and writing skills. Because in the process of using a foreign language in practice, it is required to listen to the interlocutor, to read and understand the given information, and respond orally or in writing.

By checking the level of implementation of these requirements, it is possible to assess the level of the speaker's knowledge of a foreign language.

There are a number of mock exams that allow you to test these skills at an international level and obtain a language certificate.

In particular, you can get a certificate by passing IELTS (International English Language Test System), TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), CEFR (The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). This certificate, in turn, provides opportunities to enter higher education institutions, improve qualifications, study, and work in a foreign country.

In accordance with the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 395 of May 13, 2019 "On measures to implement certificates of national and international evaluation systems for admission to higher education institutions", from the 2019-2020 academic year The following privileges have been set for the English language in entrance exams to higher education institutions:

- foreign language (English, German, French, Spanish, Turkish, Arabic, Persian, Dari, Hindi, Urdu, Chinese, Korean, Uyghur, Italian, Japanese) to the complex of tests (professional (creative) exam) (next hereinafter referred to as a foreign language) who applied for undergraduate courses of study entered as the first (main) subject and a certificate of foreign language proficiency issued by the State Test Center (hereinafter referred to as a national certificate) or international certificate International English Language Testing System (IELTS 5.5), Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL IBT 72), Cambridge Assessment English FCE international exam systems with language proficiency levels B2 or higher entrants are given the maximum points specified in this subject without exams:



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- applied to other undergraduate courses of study (with the exception of undergraduate courses of Tashkent State Law University) in which a foreign language is included as a non-first (main) subject in the set of tests (professional (creative) exam) and has a national or international certificate International English Language Testing System (IELTS 4.5), Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL IBT 42), applicants with language proficiency levels B1 and higher according to Cambridge Assessment English PET international examination systems are given the maximum points specified in this subject without exams.

- Starting from the 2020/2021 academic year, students who have applied for all undergraduate courses in which a foreign language is included in the set of tests (professional (creative) exam) and have a national or international certificate International English Language Testing System (IELTS 5.5 (in which Tashkent 5.5 points from the writing module for the state law university)), Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL IBT 72), Cambridge Assessment English FCE international exam systems B2 and higher language proficiency levels are offered to applicants with this it should be assumed that the maximum score will be given without exams.

In order to get a high level in these exams, it is necessary to teach students using effective methods.

Students can use methods such as "RadioWork", "My Voice" to develop listening skills.

In the "RadioWork" method, students are given the task of recording their voices like a radio speaker and broadcasting them interchangeably, finding pronunciation errors. Small texts can be used for this. In the "My Voice" method, it is possible to organize a small competition among students about who has the best audio recording and the correct pronunciation. This simultaneously develops the student's listening and pronunciation skills. As an additional development method, "Mind Concentration" exercises give effective results. Because concentration is important in the process of listening and understanding.

Reading is the ability to read and understand given written information. The peculiar difficulty of mastering this skill is that it requires the student to read, translate, analyze and understand the given information in a short period of time. "Best Reader", "Read Me" are offered as an effective method.

It is possible to organize a competition for reading interesting texts and stories among students using the "Best Reader" method. In this, the level of their attraction to reading will also increase.

In the "Read Me" method, students should analyze the information they have read, and tell the part that remains in their memory. But it is necessary to use information that summarizes news for students. They should also be given an understanding of how scanning and skimming methods can be used during their studies.

Writing is one of the main aspects of evaluating the level of language skills. Because the student's skillful use of words, adherence to grammar rules and ability to think are tested. To develop written speech, first of all, it is necessary to expand the student's worldview. In this, their opinions on one issue are studied using methods such as "Discussion time", "Brain Storming". Then you will be taught how to write these thoughts in an orderly manner.

In order to develop speaking skills, the aim is to reduce excitement and hesitation in students by making and speaking more texts, preparing small presentations on topics and giving them in front of the public.



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In conclusion, it should be noted that learning foreign languages is the key to opportunities in the international arena. For this reason, much attention is being paid to the young generation to learn foreign languages.

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
