

USING THE PISA FORMAT ASSIGNMENTS IN RUSSIAN LANGUAGE LESSONS AT AN UZBEK SCHOOL

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Annotation

The article discusses methodological work in schools with the Uzbek language of instruction using tasks in the "PISA" format as a means of improving the reading literacy of foreign-speaking students. A number of tasks based on the PISA technology are given.

Keywords: education, research, critical thinking, reader literacy, test tasks

The XXI century has become the century of information technology. It requires special competencies from graduates of a modern school. If yesterday good memory and encyclopedic knowledge were highly appreciated, today the ability to analyze this knowledge and extract new information from it plays an important role. For this purpose, PIZZA tests are conducted: they reflect the same changes in the education system to determine to what extent students have the skills to analyze, draw conclusions and communicate based on real events, as well as how well the education system adapts to these changes.

In December 2018, the Ministry of Public Education of Uzbekistan and the State Inspectorate for Supervision of the Quality of Education adopted a joint order "On approval of criteria for evaluating the effectiveness of educational institutions."

The participants of the meeting considered issues related to the compilation of the first rating of schools and organizational issues related to this process: the preparation of a database of schools and the conduct of control works and social surveys, surveys on the effective organization of work on Uzbekistan's participation in international knowledge assessment programs were discussed.

Uzbekistan has decided to participate in the PISA program from 2021, which will allow an objective assessment of the level of education development in

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the country and make timely decisions to eliminate shortcomings. Elements of the PISA program will also be actively used in compiling the national ranking of schools in Uzbekistan.

Responsible managers should begin work on preparing Uzbekistan's participation in the PISA program. Relevant instructions have been given for the effective organization of work in this direction.

The State Program for the implementation of the Action Strategy for the five priority Areas of Development of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2017-2021 in the "Year of Active Investment and Social Development" in paragraph 213 sets the task of establishing cooperation with the International Association for the Assessment of Educational Achievements (IEA) in order to ensure Uzbekistan's participation in international studies (PISA, TIMSS, PIRLS) within the framework of the State Program.

After reading this information, I had the idea to revise the summaries of Russian language lessons for classes with the Uzbek language of instruction. I decided to prepare assignments in accordance with the PISA tests so that foreign students would gradually get acquainted with the features of this test so that they would develop critical thinking skills. I made an attempt to develop methodological developments on the topics with which I decided to share.
