Years later, our hero, who tried to walk, became dependent on a cane. He learned the secrets of shoe repair from 2022 in hardship. A good craftsman now.

-A person should always do everything with good intentions and good deeds," says Sanjar. - When I was a child, I used to do housework. It would be difficult to look after the animals, especially on cold winter days. Then he said, "Oh, I wish I could sit motionless in front of the TV, these things are worth my life." "It's fun for disabled people, they sit in front of the TV all day without doing anything," I kept repeating. When I was 21 years old, in 2012, my legs stopped working due to a car accident.

I haven't seen a doctor in years. Sitting in front of the TV without doing anything, or rather not being able to do it, touched my soul. At the end of 2017, I started taking 2-3 steps with the help of a cane. Due to my interest in making and repairing shoes, I





devoted most of my time to learning this trade. In 2022, I opened my workshop. I am supporting my family and raising my children after my profession.



Handicraft products, shoe repair, which he prepares with delicate taste and love, is not a problem for Sanjar. He is happy to work and serve the residents of the neighborhood.

I said I won't cry, sorry I cried

... Gulnoza, who was walking on the street with the help of her sister, entered her grandmother's bed, filled her lungs and began to cry. Her grandmother stroked her hair and she was speechless for a while. what happened Knowing well that there is no need to ask his question, he said, "My daughter, my daughter, more beautiful than the moon, don't pay attention to anything. Allah tests his beloved servant by causing pain. You will grow up, achieve your dreams, become a great person. Then we will see what will happen to those who laughed at you," he reassured.

The little girl used to tell her grandmother about the derogatory words she said to the children in the street, because she often noticed that her mother cried in secret from





her at night. He did not want to make his mother's pain worse, he was in pain with his grandmother.

After such crying and crying, Gulnoza told the people around her: "You know nothing!", "We don't want to be friends with you!", "You are nobody!" learned to ignore such words. He got used to being above words and carelessness. He spent most of his time reading books.



Gulnoza Chorshanbieva, the second child of a happy family, was born with a disability. But even though he could not play on the street like his peers, he never stopped dreaming, thinking, reading books. Gulnoza, who aims to become a psychologist in the future, lives in "Oftobmakon" neighborhood of our district.

-Actually, a person's life is measured by good and bad deeds, the only thing that remains is good," says Gulnoza Chorshanbieva. - If there are more people who love their country and its people with good deeds, our country will flourish. I intend to become a psychologist in the future. I am trying to master the necessary subjects for

Rajabali Almanov, who lives in the "Oliyhimmat" neighborhood of our district and has been a teacher for many years, currently has limited opportunities. Every day, he intends to go out to the neighborhood and talk with his peers, but because he cannot walk, he is limited to listening to the radio.



It will be difficult if a person who is standing on his feet in every job of the neighborhood, who gave education to the youth of the neighborhood, becomes bedridden due to illness.

- I want to go to the neighborhood, to the houses of neighbors and talk with them, says the father. - But since I can't walk, the neighbors will come and inform me. May God bless you, my appeal to the district mayor for a wheelchair was resolved positively. Now, with the help of a modern wheelchair, I had the opportunity to go to the street, to the neighbors' houses.

There are many lows and highs in life. Asliddin Jumev, a resident of "Oftobmakon" neighborhood, was not spared the test of fate. Asliddin, who works in the construction industry with good intentions, fell down due to carelessness. But he did not stop.
