



CONTENT OF ASSESSMENT OF THE STUDENT'S COMPETENCES IN LEARNING THE GERMAN LANGUAGE

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Abstract

The article talks about the importance of test tasks in assessing the student's competencies in mastering the German language, and suggests the developmental purpose of the test. In this regard, specific suggestions are made and the essence of the issue is revealed.

It is known that test assignments form the student's competence knowledge by developing knowledge, skills and abilities of students. Tests in this regard

- a multiple-choice test with one correct answer
- an alternative answer test task with several correct answers
- "binary" test task
- a test task that requires filling in the blanks
- a test task that requires an extended answer
- pictorial test assignment
- divided into methodical types such as error correction tests.

Such assignments help activate the student's learning process, develop observation, attention, memory and thinking skills. Such tasks can be used both to test and strengthen the knowledge gained, and to expand and deepen it.

Such tests are widely used at all stages of the lesson when asking questions, learning new material, and correcting. Test tasks have a special place in the educational process, because they are one of the forms of intellectual activity. They show the educational impact of the student and whether it allows you to get a lot of new information. The pedagogical importance of test tasks is as follows:

- modeling life situations of competition between people, as well as creating conditions for interaction and mutual support;
- creates a commonality among participants and achieves a specific goal through joint efforts;





they are given the opportunity to be in certain life situations and develop a behavioral model.

The test tasks allow to determine the personal qualities of the participants, among which courtesy, resourcefulness and perseverance are of particular importance. It takes into account how honest the child is during the game, because he must not break the rules to achieve his goal. Participants of test assignments enjoy not only winning, but also expanding their worldview. The event is aimed at the development of the child's non-standard thinking, as well as the formation of intellectual reaction and intuition.

Assignments that serve to form the student's knowledge of the German language were given.
